# The Women's Therapy Centre (WTC) Closure Statement

We regret to announce the imminent closure of the Women's Therapy Centre (WTC). For an explanation see the statement below issued by the Board of Directors.

We sincerely thank our past and present clients, staff members, volunteers, friends, colleagues, funders and donors and all who have supported the necessary work of the Centre during the last 6 years.

From all at the WTC

"The Directors and the Board of Management of the Women's Therapy Centre (Ireland) Limited have, with the deepest regret, been left with no option but to close the Women's Therapy Centre at 23 Herbert Street. All service will be wound down over the next number of weeks. This decision is taken in the light of the financial circumstances of the Centre, as there is no core funding available to sustain the work of the Centre. The Centre is fully committed to meeting its current obligations.

The Directors and the Board would like to express their gratitude and appreciation to all our funders – especially the Sisters of Mercy and Saint John of God Order – friends, supporters and members of the public for their support over the past six years, who have recognised

the need for a mental health service for women. We thank our past and present clients and acknowledge the work and commitment of the staff and volunteers in providing services to support women.

We apologise to all waiting for our counselling service — we will be in contact with each of you to discuss alternative services.

We are currently working with forty three clients and there are forty eight women on the waiting list. These are very stark statistics, reflecting the need for a dedicated service for women's health. We have been meeting that need in this agency. We are confident that we have brought attention to the need for this work and thank all who have supported us."
